- Review By-Laws
 - Purpose is to support school groups that form outside of the classroom.
 - Basic Policies (see by-laws)
 - Membership is open to everyone.(\$25 for a family membership)
- General Meetings
 - One “general membership” meeting required every year.
 - Special Meetings may be called by the executive committee
 - Committee meetings are encouraged to happen between sport seasons
- Finances
 - Accountable to the School Board
 - Maintain a Checking Account that may be reviewed by school administration
 - Use to pay for expenses associated with Booster Club activities
- Activities and Projects
 - The Booster Club will notify and obtain approval from school administration for all activities and projects. Committee chairs are responsible for providing a proposed calendar of activities and events to the Executive Committee for review and approval at the beginning of each school year.
 - The Booster Club may request advance funding of expenses from activities and projects from the School Board. Such requests shall be in written form and include a proposed budget showing anticipated income and expense of the project.
- Governance
 - Executive Committee shall be the President, the President-Elect, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the immediate Past President, the Headmaster of Crossings Christian School and a School Board member appointed by the School Board as a liaison. President is appointed by Executive committee
